In January of 2016, my husband and I welcomed a precious baby boy into the world. Leading up to his birth, we prayed constantly, read every childcare book, watched every parenting series, and received advice (some wanted, some unwanted) from everyone in our lives. When the doctor told us we could take him home from the hospital, we both glanced at each other with the same look of worry and unease. We still felt so unprepared to take this small human home. We knew that every decision we made for him over the next 18 years would help shape him into the person he would ultimately become.

Fast forward four years, we are getting ready to enroll that sweet little boy in PreK for the first time. As parents, we have the responsibility of choosing the school that he will spend over 8 hours a day for the next 14 years. For the first time since being the admissions director, I am seeing the perspective of our new families who are deciding to invest in their child's education by enrolling them at Prince. Here are some of the items prospective families look at when considering our school:

ACADEMICS. Academically, our students excel when they graduate from Prince. They score well on standardized testing and get accepted to great colleges and universities. They get to participate in wonderful elective courses beginning in PreK such as computers, Spanish, art, music, and physical education. From our youngest learners to our seniors, you can find them doing hands-on science labs that fuel their love for learning. They take engaging field trips that allow them to see their studies in action. Prince strives to make learning effective, engaging, and fun for all students. Additionally, the majority of our faculty not only hold advanced degrees, they genuinely care for the students they teach. They pray with their students.
